How it works

Please email me (jean@jkellerart.com) several CLEAR, well-lit photographs/and or videos to choose from. Indicate if you have a favorite, but I will ultimately choose the one I feel is best to work from. I find it best if you have an image where you and your pet have established direct eye-contact, or is looking directly at the camera or has a "signature look" that is present in their eyes.

Size and Pricing

I use standard size options for ease of framing. Square or rectangle? I will recommend the best crop of the photo I will be painting from. We will decide this before I begin the painting process. My smallest size option is 8x8. Prices start at \$450 unframed.

Pricing may be affected by the level of detail or specific requirements. The prices listed here are <u>for</u> <u>one animal only per painting</u>. My style is moderately tight with a focus on the eyes and face. It will present as a classic "head and shoulders" portrait and there will be little to no detail in background. If you specify more than one animal and/or a higher level of detail, it will be reflected in the price.

The painting will be finished with a Gamblin Gloss Retouch varnish (to protect and heighten the color). All paintings are sold UNFRAMED unless otherwise specified. I'm also happy to frame it for you for an additional fee!

Once a size and image are selected I require 1/2 the full amount to hold your space in my queue. I can then give you a rough estimate of when you can expect your painting to be completed. Please remember: you are commissioning a one-of-a-kind piece of fine art. "Generally" (and I am going to use that term loosely) allow 2 weeks for completion and delivery. Might be sooner... <u>I will not ship a wet</u> <u>painting.</u> If you need it for a gift and it's not ready, I can supply you with a presentation certificate.

Commissions are not returnable

Your commissioned portrait is representative of my skills and I strive for 100% satisfaction. However, if you are unhappy with your custom portrait for any reason, I will return your initial deposit of 1/2 the quoted price. The finished painting will then become property of JKellerArt along with exclusive rights.

Unless we agree otherwise, your painting will be shipped via UPS and will be <u>insured and require a</u> <u>signature</u>. Shipping fee is extra.

Choosing the right photo

Once I have the photo, I can crop it to make a good composition, which I will then email back for your approval. At that time we might discuss background/details/color choices. Sometimes a CLEAR still from a video might be the best way to capture the essence of your pet's personality!

Timeline

Two things will contribute to the timeline: your order in the queue and the general nature of oil painting. Expect at least 2 weeks from start to finish. Please note: <u>I will not ship a wet painting</u>.

- 3. Send the 50% deposit via PayPal, Venmo or Zelle transfer.
- 4. Your commission is now in the queue! I'll sketch up the best composition for the size and finalize any questions I might have!
- 5. As soon as it's finished I will email a watermarked proof and request for the balance due.
- 6. You pay the balance.
- 7. I'll pack and ship your painting via UPS.
- 8. Your beautiful custom painting arrives!
